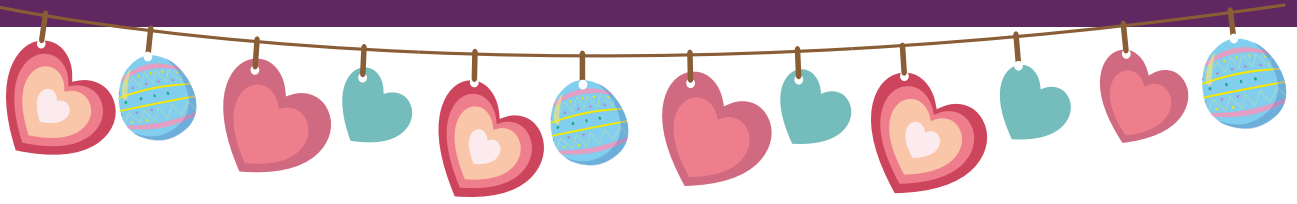

Our Workshops

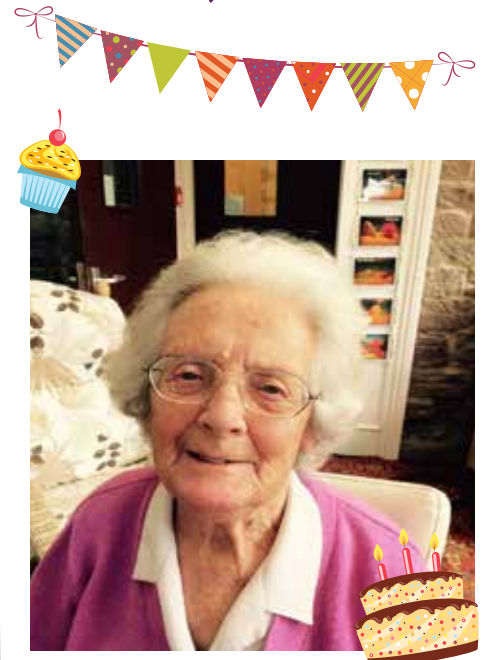
Our residents at Sydenham House have been very busy attending our workshops.
